It is – LEGAL – to buy and consume Raw Milk here in Arkansas – in 2014 Act 1209 was passed allowing farmers to sell from their farm direct to the consumer, some farmers require you bring your own container, others will just sell you by the jar, for the latest list of Raw Milk farmers, use the website.
